Final Instructions For Concert State

General:

- Bring 4 CLEAN originals of the music with measures numbered for judges and clinician.
 - Your accompanist may use a copy for ease of page turning but there must also be an original visible.
- Chaperone list, one for every ten students not including director.
- Cell phone numbers for director and chaperones.
- 4 copies of the auxillary information sheets (optional but recommended).
- Collect all student cell phones before the block starts.
- Parents are not allowed to be on their cell phones.
- There is NO ON SITE FOOD available at North and Central. Students may bring food but it is not to be consumed inside any of the buildings. Please do not ask for special accomaditions directly of the church. They do not have the capacity to handle us in this manner. If you have food delivered to the church, please be sure delivery people have your number or the chaperone in charge. DO NOT give out the church phone number or have them check in at the FVA office. We will not be able to responsible for your food delivery.
- At check out be sure you have all your music, recordings, and rating sheets and be sure they are for your school. Sometimes music and/or sheets migrate to other piles.
- You are required to stay for an entire block unless you are scheduled over 2 blocks in which case the choirs may leave after their last group clinic. Please have all students remain in the performance hall until the clinic has been completed for that last choir.
- Each choir has one hour of time for warm up, performance, and clinic
- BE ON TIME!!!! The schedules are tight and it is difficult to adjust them.
 - If you are running late and won't arrive 30 minutes prior to your block start time, please call Shelli Long at 904-226-3263. My cell will be on silent as I'm usually in the auditorium/sanctuary during the blocks.
- Please monitor your students as we are in three very nice venues and we want to be able to use them again. No student may leave the audience area without a chaperone. This is a disqualification possibility if students are found without a chaperone.
- This year I have scheduled over 200 choirs in 3 different locations. That's a good problem to have. We will have some growing pains this year and I will adjust for next year.
