## ALL-STATE 2019 *MIDDLE SCHOOL TREBLE CHORUS*

What you need to know to make it a successful and rewarding experience for your All-State Musician!

### #FMEA2019

- ★ JOIN REMIND group (chaperones & students - on your phones!) to stay “Informed” of latest news/reminders.
  - TEXT @flastc19 to the number 81010
- ★ Plan on attending chaperone meeting on Thursday afternoon.
- ★ All-State students must wear their name badge at ALL times.
- ★ REHEARSAL schedule - allow plenty of time to arrive early (within 30 minutes of rehearsal).
- ★ WHAT TO WEAR?
  - REHEARSALS - casual, school-type clothing (sweaters/ballrooms tend to be cold) - adhere to school dress-code policy.
  - CONCERT - formal chorus uniform; if your school doesn't have one - NICE all black clothing (long skirt/dress for the ladies, please).
- ★ FOOD/meals?
  - Chaperones are to pick-up/meet students during lunch/dinner breaks. Students must be supervised during meal breaks.
  - Parents/chaperones - plan ahead on meals! Suggestions: utilize the Hilton lobby “to-go” meals; order in advance while students are in rehearsal; purchase ahead breakfast items/sandwiches...
  - NO outside food is to be taken into the hotel unless it is being taken to your guest room for consumption.

- ❖ REHEARSALS -
- STUDENTS MUST HAVE ALL ORIGINAL MUSIC OCTAVOS for rehearsals on Thursday and Friday.
  - MUSIC will be checked at first rehearsal/Thursday afternoon.
- Bring pencils, water (if possible) - ONLY WATER permitted in rehearsal.
- Arrange meeting location (away from main hallway/level 2) at conclusion of rehearsals.
- Use the restroom during meal breaks prior to rehearsal, if possible.
- One chaperone per school should be in rehearsal room/nearby at all times.
- PARENTS/CHAPERONES - you WILL NOT be permitted to stay around the rehearsal hall corridors/surroundings while rehearsals are in session. You may observe rehearsals with a chaperone badge.

## **Ticket Information**

- ❖ **CONCERT TICKETS** - Registered (**BADGED**) attendees/chaperones do not require tickets to attend any All-State concert.
- ❖ Chaperone badges serve as your entrance to any All-State concert.
- ❖ All non-registered attendees (non-badged-parents, family members, guests, etc.) are required to purchase tickets for any All-State concert they wish to attend at **\$15.00/ticket**.
- ❖ Everyone, regardless of age, who will take up a seat must have a ticket. Only infants who will sit in a parent's lap, will not require a ticket.
- ❖ General ticket sales for All-State concerts will begin at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday at the FMEA registration desk in Tampa Convention Center. Starting at 9:00am on Saturday, all remaining tickets for STRAZ concerts will be sold at the STRAZ.

## **Curfew Information**

- ❖ **Curfew for students on Weds. - Sat. evening is from 11:00 p.m. - 6:00 a.m.**
- ❖ **Students must remain in their rooms during curfew hours.**
- ❖ **Students violating curfew will be subject to dismissal from any All-State group and may be sent home at parent expense.**
- ❖ **Students must be respectful in hotels throughout conference stay.**

## ★ **CONCERT DAY- Final Rehearsal - Saturday, January 12th**

- **CONCERT UNIFORM** - formal chorus uniform; if your school doesn't have one - NICE all black clothing (long skirt/dress for the ladies, please!
- NO sneakers, jeans, shorts, t-shirts, spaghetti straps, or flip-flops.
- Students do not need to bring music to rehearsal on concert morning.
- Make your plans for the early morning -
  - Students COME DRESSED & ready to Saturday morning rehearsal check-in time.
  - Students should not bring jackets, bags, etc. to Saturday rehearsal/concert.
  - "Lite" breakfast, but please eat something!
  - Good idea to check out the **STRAZ Center for the Performing Arts** prior to concert morning!
  - Drop off/pick-up location (stage door/security entrance) will be discussed on-site at Friday afternoon rehearsal.
  - PRIOR to concert rehearsal "check-in" - Choose a spot to meet chaperones/family at the conclusion of concert.

## **All-State shirts, pins, plaques, CD/DVD orders**

- ❖ Can be purchased at the convention center throughout conference.
- ❖ Plaques and concert CD/DVD orders will be available in the lobby at the Saturday concert.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

- ❖ **I lost my badge? How do I get another one?**
  - You must contact your student's director to get a replacement badge. Student/parent will be responsible for cost to replace.
- ❖ **Why might I want a chaperone badge?**
  - With a chaperone badge, you may observe rehearsals, attend concerts, and visit the exhibit hall at no additional charge.
  - Contact your child's director regarding chaperone registration or purchasing separate concert tickets and exhibit hall day passes.
- ❖ **What do I do if I lost my music?**
  - It is the student's/parent's responsibility to acquire a complete packet of original music prior to arrival. Any student without a complete packet of original music at the first rehearsal, must see the choir coordinator to make arrangements for immediate CASH purchase.
